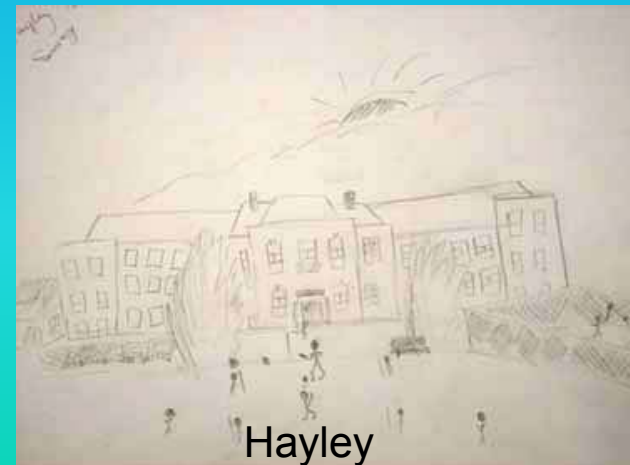

- The earliest lighthouses were originally bonfires built on the side of hills to guide ships.
- Lighthouses are put on an important space on the coastline.
- They are sometimes put on the entrance to harbours and estuaries, on rocky ledges or reefs and possibly all alone on a little island!
- Lighthouses help define a ships location.
- Lighthouses warn the ships of hazards and notify them that the land is near.
