BrewDog Trashy Blonde Pale Ale *abv 4.1%*

As the label implies BrewDog are not like any other brewery. They make uncompromising, artisan beer and this is a fragrant, passionfruit-infused Pale Ale that is ultra-refreshing.

Lovibonds Henley Gold (bottle conditioned wheat beer) *abv 4.6%*

Oxfordshire, England

Brewed using a traditional Bavarian yeast this stunning summery wheat beer has flavours of banana and cloves with a slight sweetness, but at the same time is exceptionally revitalising.

Suthwyk Ales 'Liberation' (bottle conditioned) *abv 4.2%*

Produced at the historic Southwick brewhouse, local legend has it that General Montgomery and Eisenhower used to come and enjoy a pint here while planning D-Day. Hence the name of this refreshing, hoppy beer.

This is lighter (and lower in alcohol) than a traditional IPA, however it still exudes the same pungent, hoppy aromas that make this such a thirst-quenching, drinkable style.

This is crisp, dry and a very refreshing pilsner full of grapefruity zestiness.

Cains Finest Lager *abv 5%*

The Dusanj brothers have created an iconic British lager. Full in flavour and smooth, it is very much style of the classic European lagers.

Kernel IPA Centennial (bottle conditioned) *abv (6.2%-7.8%)*

This brand new Brewery is a stone's throw from Tate. Centennial is the name of an American hop that gives this beer its distinct fruity, citrus characters. See also their majestic porter overleaf.

This beer, brewed in Battersea at the Sambrooks brewery, is a hoppy ale with a balanced sweetness and malty, fruity finish. Worryingly easy to drink.

Based in Chiswick, Fuller's London Pride is one of the capital's iconic beers.

Innis & Gunn Oak Aged Beer abv 6.6%

Edinburgh, Scotland

Apparently this brewery discovered, by accident, that maturing their beer in an oak barrel (a process more readily associated with wine) improved it. A stroke of luck as the results are superb, with its flavours of caramel and spice.

Created in 1995 to commemorate the brewery's 150th anniversary this is a rich, malty beer full of dried fruits and spice, with a clean hoppy finish.

Harviestoun 'Old Engine Oil' abv 6%

Alva, Scotland

This fabulous name was dreamt up by the original head brewer. He previously designed model prototypes for Ford. The colour of his creation reminded him of thick engine oil. Luckily the taste is quite different, with flavours of chocolate and coffee balanced by a hoppy bitterness.

BrewDog Paradox Imperial Stout abv 10%

Aberdeenshire, Scotland

This is the most fantastic stuff. BrewDog's imperial stout is aged in Arran Whisky casks. This lends the beer rich layers of vanilla and cinnamon with hints of fruit and ginger which are inherent in Arran Malt Whisky.
