

What you need: Peculiarities Activity Sheet for leader; pens.

Instructions

1. Divide into 5 groups of 4.
2. Explain that the object of the activity is to discover peculiarities in the group.
3. They will each get a list of peculiarities. They then have to tick off the ones that apply to all of the people in the group. If they come up with more they can add them to the list. Having gone through the peculiarities, each person in the group takes a note of somebody else peculiarity and presents it to the rest of the group.

15. Has a twin brother or sister.
